



## TEAM REGISTRATION PROCESS FOR COUNTYWIDE KENYA TECH CHALLENGE 2025

### **Step 1: Announcement of the Tech Challenge (January 24th, 2025)**

- All schools are invited to register their teams, each guided by an advisor - 1-2 teams per advisor. We encourage schools to register anywhere between 2-10 teams per school.
- An advisor can only manage no more than two teams. A team cannot have more than 6 students.
- Please encourage every team to **submit a final submission form by May 27th, 2025** (see below) so that they can have the opportunity to be selected for the Tech Challenge Kenya: Drop and Dash.
- Schools are encouraged to register up to 10 teams for participation for the Tech Challenge.
- The first 50 schools to register will get a bag of materials and connectors.

### **Step 2: Final Submission of Photos, Videos, and Journal (Registration for this form will be available April 15th, to be completed by May 27th, 2025 FINAL Deadline).**

- The final submission form will open on April 15th, 2025, there will be a link on our webpage [thetech.org/ttc-kenya](http://thetech.org/ttc-kenya).
- Schools must submit team performance evidence
  - 1 minute video describing how the device will be made and the engineering design thinking behind the construction of the device. Please note: at this point, you do not need to show the full device ready.
  - 30 second video of the team of students sharing their ideas or sharing something about themselves including collaboration and process.
  - 5 pictures of the team journal pages from their meetings

### **Step 3: Selection of Top Entries and Notification of Selected teams**

- Local judges and the Tech team will review all submissions to identify the most outstanding entries.
- Selected teams will be invited and notified to attend the Tech Challenge Showcase.
- The Tech Challenge (TTC) will inform all teams of the **final decision by June 5th 2025**. Schools with teams not selected will be notified with a message of gratitude for their participation.
- We look forward to seeing your students' innovative ideas!
